Summary of Position:

The Peer Support Specialist will serve as an advocate and support for consumers and families and will assist them in developing personal goals for recovery from mental health and/or substance abuse/dependence. This position does require personal lived experience with mental illness. The Peer Support Specialist will assist in creating an individualized health and safety plan, will teach and role model the value of the recovery experience and will develop a supportive and positive relationship with the clients. This is a part-time position (10-20 hours per week).

Qualifications/Requirements:

Current/past personal experience as a consumer of mental health services and be at a point in your recovery where you can share your experiences with others. Must have a good working knowledge of mental health services, community resources and how to access these resources. The ability to work with a diverse population as well as with and in difficult emotional situations is important.
